# ARLES IN A FEW HOURS



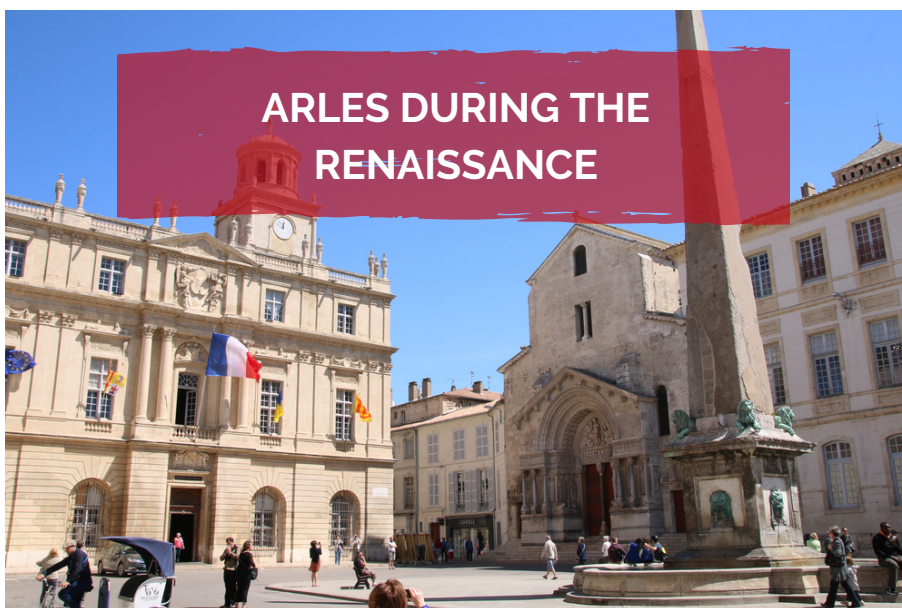

From Roman times until today, passing by Van Gogh, discover and appreciate the monuments of Arles that are part of the UNESCO World Heritage Monuments : the Roman theatre, the amphitheatre, the Baths of Constantine, St. Trophime's church...

In 46 BC, after his victory over Marseille, Julius Caesar thanked the Arlesians for their help by founding a colony in Arles under Roman law, with a huge territory. Very quickly prosperous, the city was enriched with superb monuments: the forum, temples, the theater, the amphitheater, the circus, thermal baths .... Go back in time during this 100% ancient visit!

During the Renaissance, the city experienced a flourishing period : Noble families built or embellished their vast residences and mansions. Come and discover this burst of creativity inspired by Antiquity!

Ancient, medieval and Renaissance city, city of art, capital of the Camargue, Arles has an exceptionally well preserved architectural heritage.

You will be able to immerse yourself in the history of the city thanks to an in-depth visit in the heart of the protected sector.

Deeply marked by the great periods of History, Arles has kept impressive testimonies: its historical center but also its museums. The departmental archeological museum of Arles which restores the heritage bequeathed to us by the Romans or the Réattu museum, a fine arts museum which houses works by the painter Jacques Réattu as well as a collection of drawings by Picasso or the Museon Arlaten created on the initiative of Frédéric Mistral in 1899, this museum is devoted to the ethnography of Provence. You will discover the historical center and one of these museums during the visit.

Meet a guide at the Arles tourist office and leave for the Camargue. Enjoy the natural and wild landscapes, along the Vaccarès pond to Saintes Maries de la Mer. Return to Arles planned at the end of the tour.

In the morning, your guide will take you on a tour of the historic centre. The "Little Rome of the Gauls" boasts a fine array of ancient monuments and works of art that celebrate the ingenuity of the Romans.

The day continues with a visit to the Musée Départemental Arles Antique. This museum immerses visitors in the living memory of the city. Witness the rich ancient past of Arles, and discover the major works (bust of Julius Caesar, models of monuments, and the Gallo-Roman barge Arles Rhône 3...).
