Let's start at ...

La Capelière

Information centre of the Camargue National Reserve : the reception, a bookshop, an exhibition, a nature trail with information panels, 4 hides overlooking the marshes and 2 platforms overlooking the Vaccarès reedbeds.
- from 01/04 to 30/09 : 9 am-1 pm and 2 pm-6 pm
- from 01/10 to 31/03 : 9 am-1 pm and 2 pm-5 pm
except tuesday

Full fare : 3 € - Half fare : 1,50 €

Then discover a well-preserved landscape... Salin de Badon

4.5 km of footpaths and 3 hides, in a beautiful area that was formerly a royal salina. Access is limited in order to reduce disturbance and to allow you to enjoy your visit. Open throughout the year from dawn to dusk.

Full fare : 3 € - Half fare : 1,50 €

Combined ticket Capelière and Salin de Badon : 4,50 €

"From the dike ... to the sea" La Gacholle

20 km of trails through the reserve, free of access on foot or by bicycle. From Les Saintes Maries de la Mer to "La Comtesse", the sea dike lies between the lagoons and the beach and allows you to discover extensive areas of salt steppe in the heart of the reserve. You can stop at the Gacholle lighthouse and visit the exhibition on the Camargue coastline (free of charge, open on week-ends and during the school holidays from 11 am to 5 pm)
