### ROMAN ARLES

In 46 B.C., after his victory over the Marseille soldiers, Julius Caesar thanked the inhabitants of Arles for their help by creating a colony there, ruled by Roman law and covering an immense territory. It soon became prosperous and superb monuments were built : Forum, temples, theater, amphitheater, circus, baths.. Go back in time during this 100% Roman visit!

### IN THE FOOTSTEPS OF VINCENT VAN GOGH

Plunge into the history of the famous Dutch artist, Vincent van Gogh, whose creativity was at its height during his stay in Arles between 1888 and 1889.

He did about 200 paintings in Arles, including some of his most famous ; The café in the evening, the Langlois bridge, Stary night over the Rhone... This tour will lead you in van Gogh's footsteps to the places he loved such as the public park on the Boulevard des Lices, the Place du Forum, the amphitheatre, the Trinquetaille bridge... where you can still feel the atmosphere of his tormented and immortal presence.

You will learn all about the history of the city during this detailed visit in the heart of the historic city center.

### ARLES + ONE MUSEUM

Arles has been shaped by all of the important periods in History, and has been able to preserve impressive remains in its historic center but also in its museums. The "musée départemental Arles antique" (archaeological museum) exhibits the heritage passed down by the Romans, or the Réattu Museum, Fine Arts museum containing the works of the Arlesian painter Jacques Réattu and a collection of drawings by Picasso. You will discover the historic city center and one of our museums during this visit.
